
- The pre-registration period will open starting **9:00 AM EST on Wednesday, February 10, 2021**. Entities will have until **5:00 PM EST on Monday, February 22, 2021** to complete their pre-registration. Only entities that pre-register will be eligible to apply for a Phase 2 Loan.
- The pre-registration process is NOT first come, first served. Entities can pre-register at any point during this pre-registration period, but will not be able to do so after the pre-registration period closes.
- It is not recommended to wait until just before the deadline of **5:00 PM EST on Monday, February 22, 2021** in order to start your pre-registration.


- If you do not currently have a user name and password, click the Register tab at the top to create a new user name and password.

- Once you have created or located your username and password, make sure you write it down and that it is easy for you to locate as you will need it any time you need to access the portal.






#### **Creating a New User Name and Password (if you do not have one)**






### If You Were Emailed an Invitation Code





# **Provide General Information about the Business or Entity**



There is a limit of one loan application per EIN. If you have multiple EINs and wish to apply for a loan for each EIN, you will need to complete a separate pre-registration for each EIN. If you have multiple locations under a single EIN, you may only apply once under the sole EIN.



# Provide Your Primary Business Address and Mailing Address (if mailing address is different than primary address)

### **Primary Business Address** Your primary business location is the address where most of your employees are working. If no one location has the most employees because multiple locations have e same number, then the primary location from among those locations is the one that generates the most revenue. If there are still multiple locations that meet the criteria, the primary location is the location that opened first. 


